OBSERVATIONS FROM RESEARCHERS

Nancetta Wagner Research Specialist

What a wonderful opportunity to have been a part of the creation and development of this Directory of Support and Counselling programs focusing on the Health and Wellness of Men, Elder Men and Boys throughout British Columbia.

All organizations I contacted agreed to take part in the survey, and about 20% responded saying: "There is a real need **to have** or **to have more** programs in our area but lack funding" "What a great idea, a men's directory" and "Happy to hear someone's taking the initiative to get more men's programs out there."

I explained that by completing the survey they are helping us identify regional gaps and shortfalls in men's programs. I found it disheartening to hear them talk about the number of programs that had to close over the years because funding was no longer available. On the other hand, I found it quite refreshing that half of the participants wanted to know about the programs Grant is currently running at West Coast Men's Support Society.

Knowing that the data we collect will be presented to the Government seemed to give them hope. Hope that their voices will make a difference and give proof of ***the need for Men's Programs in their regions and Funding to support them.***

Being a part of this project was quite an eye opener for me when it comes to the state of social programming that is available for Senior Men and Men in the province of BC. During our initial research we found well over 500 organizations that seemed to have programs that benefited the targeted demographic of this project. During the survey phase of the project, we were able to contact and send surveys out to over 80% of the organizations from our initial research. The response rate of the survey was approximately 20%, and through the responses we were able to compile a list of 176 programs. The disheartening part for me, lies in the fact that out of all these programs, there are only 20 whose participant is either a Senior Man or Man only. On a better note, over 50% of all organizations that actively took part in the project by responding with our survey, are interested in obtaining more information about programs that are currently running here at the West Coast Men's Support Society.

This project was my first introduction to the world of social services and programming. I am not trained in social services nor have I worked in a non-profit organization before. My opinions with respect to this project is that of an average person who is looking at the data from an outside perspective. My opinion is influenced by the fact that I myself am a married, middle aged, father of 4, who is part of the targeted demographic of this project. It is my opinion, after taking part in this project and having spoken to many contacts at organizations throughout the province; that there are entirely too few programs available for Senior Men and Men in our province.

PROVINCIAL ORGANIZATION

Mankind Project of British Columbia

Counselling for men has very little public funding support. The Mankind Project has developed a support network that is funded by participants and through volunteer activities.

CARIBOO REGION

Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Quesnel

There is a gap in men's counselling and support programs in our community.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Williams Lake

There are always far more boys that could benefit from mentoring than there are male volunteers, both teen and adult. The scope of our programming is scaled appropriately to the limited funding we receive.

Crisis Prevention, Intervention and Information Centre for Northern BC

Lack of funding for all programs

Kikino Métis Children and Family Services

Locally our Northern Health became interested in our group of men and in 2010 did interviews and a report followed. Since then a Northern Health Men's project came out of that and we were also involved in a documentary created by Northern Health Men's Project and our local TV station (CKPG) By being a part of this documentary that aired in Prince George on Father's Day weekend we have also received a few hits and have had more men come into our program/group who want to make changes in their lives and become healthy for themselves and their families. We also have at least two men who have really started making differences in the way they handle their stress in a good and healthy way and who have also had their children removed and they have been successful in getting their families back together etc. Both men have stated how important the program is to them and the changes it has done for them and their families. They stated just knowing there was other men with similar struggles they felt comfortable in coming in for the help. This program is not funded and we search out various grants to try to support this group. If you have any questions feel free to contact me. Thank you

Surpassing Our Survival (S.O.S. Society)

I think at this point we're still facing some societal limitations for men to seek help. In our northern context this creates a significant limitation to getting an adequate number of men to participate, which affect funding! I think we need to go to great lengths to create more public awareness and start creating more conversations around it being okay for men to feel and for men to confront their inner turmoil.

The Compassionate Friends of Canada - Prince George

No comment at this time.

KOOTENAY REGION

Boundary Family & Individual Services Society

Lack of funding - Service to rural areas is very limited - No assaultive men's program available to men and families that would benefit - Community bias against men who are in acrimonious relationship situations - Need more education - People have to travel to outlying communities for court - Lack of addictions treatment and detox - Systemic issues around the delivery of addictions services - Need comprehensive men's services similar to services for women

Castlegar & District Community Services Society

Kristein responded by email that they are interested in starting Men's programs but as usual the issue is funding and the lack there of.

Columbia Valley Family Resource Centre

There has been a serious lack of funding and also a lack of commitment on the part of men. In general, men do not like receiving counselling support.

Freedom Quest Regional Youth Services - Castlegar

There is always a lack of funding, lack of participants in a small town to necessitate having an entire men's program, many participants with transportation barriers may not be able to access program.

Kootenay Boundary Community Services Co-operative

As with most services, the money is available "downstream" to "fix the broken", but there is no money available to do preventative work. Frustrating and discouraging.

Nelson Community Services Centre

Program ended upon completion of one time funding - that would be the only negative comment. Community was positively impacted by this mentoring project and is in part responsible for possibly bringing Big Brothers Big Sister Organization to the West Kootenays.

North Kootenay Lake Community Services Society

We are aware that there is a need for a wider range of counselling for men. We are able to offer counselling for men when there is a substance use or mental health issue or if there is a need for counselling around parenting or if they have been a victim of crime. We have had to turn male clients away who do not fit in these areas. This has included men who are seeking help dealing with anger issues. We are unable to provide other areas of counselling due to a lack of funding.

Salmo Community Resource Society

A few years ago a Men's/Dads program ran here in Salmo. The participants found this to be a helpful experience - sharing concerns, challenges and celebrations with the others involved. Lack of funding as well as a lack of male on staff qualified to hold the space and facilitate the meeting. Still looking for funding to have Shamus meet with dads and younger aged children.

MAINLAND/SOUTHWEST REGION

Ambleside Youth Centre - District of West Vancouver

We have more male referrals than female; therefore, have two male Youth Outreach Workers to attempt to accommodate the numbers. However, we sometimes carry a waitlist for one-to-one support, but are able to offer out-trips and group work and a connection to our youth centre while they wait. The average wait time for individual support is less than 2 weeks.

BC Men's Resource Centre

Few, if any, resources for male victims of domestic violence (for example, individual/group counselling; safe houses for these men). Housing for men who are kicked out of their homes by their partners, are asked to leave their homes by their partners, or who want time away from their partners. Lack of inclusion in events/networks offered to other groups (for example, meetings of agencies offering victim services). Help for parents who are in the MCFD (child protection) system.

BC Society for Male Survivors of Sexual Assault

There is a lack of funding for support programs specific to men. There are no shelters specifically for men or any other agencies that work specifically with men that have experienced trauma. The language used in many writings also uses men vs. women violence which is unilateral. A slow recognition that men are also victims is evident. Our clients find that gaining access to housing, social assistance and legal counsel very challenging due to the lack of funding.

Big Brothers and Big Sisters of the Fraser Valley

In all cases, programming is available dependent on the availability of suitable mentors and subject to sufficient funding. There is no fee for the programming but funding is required in order to be able to deliver the programming. All volunteers are subject to a stringent screening process and each program has monitoring requirements. Parents are encouraged to be part of the monitoring processes. There is always a shortage of volunteers, especially men. Consider making a difference in the life of a child...and in your life too.

Bowen Island Family Place

We have not offered any men's counselling or support programs. We have offered parent education talks geared to parents of young children; the majority of participants have been mothers.

Change Of Seasons Consulting

The reason that I have been asked to complete this, I think, is because the Change of Seasons program name was deliberately used to honour a program that I co-founded in North Vancouver of the same name. That program no longer exists due to lack of funding. When it did exist much of the program leaders time and energy was spent in renewing grant applications, fulfilling funder requirements and creatively fundraising to the detriment of the client population. Men's programs remain (20 years later) a difficult sell with funding bodies in most parts of Canada. I left Vancouver shortly after most of the Domestic Violence programs for men were de-funded and correctional programs for men turned over to prison staff for delivery.

Chilliwack Community Services

We have recently had to make the decision to drastically scale back our "Nurturing Fathers" program due to a reduction in funding. There is a strong need for low or no cost counselling for men in their role as fathers.

Dale Trimble and Associates

There's a lack of treatment programs for men who have used violence in their families.

Dr. Harry Stefanakis Inc.

Lack of funding for men's treatment programs especially for non-court ordered men attempting to address issues of emotion management and abuse.

Howe Sound Women's Centre Society - Squamish

There are not a lot of services for men who need support with emotional issues in our community. It would be great to see a Men's Drop In here.

MOSAIC

I believe this is still the only program targeting men who are at risk of committing/repeating acts of aggression/violence in the domestic context in Vancouver & the Lower Mainland. Most of our participants are referred by the MCFD and the Justice System, very (very) few are self referred. It seems difficult to find funding sources for these kinds of programs.

Options Community Services

I manage the Stopping the Violence programs at Options and these include two transition houses (Virginia Sam and Evergreen), Children Who Witness Abuse, and Threshold Multicultural Outreach. I specifically have not offered any men's programs.

Stand by your Women

Thanks very much for including me in this.

The Family Education & Support Centre

We have had great success in easily attracting and retaining men for our anger management programs, and have a small but steady flow of men attending our parenting education and support programs. We have been hesitant to offer additional programming for men as we are unsure how to find and attract men to groups, any suggestion as to where to market and how to structure programs in a way that honours the differences between female needs in groups and the needs of males would be invaluable to our small organization. We have the facilities and the desire, but we lack expertise in this field.

Tri-City Men's Resource Centre Society

Organization ran for approximately 4 years and primarily closed due to a lack of funding for programs.

Tri-City Transitions Society

We offered a program called Secrets to Fatherhood; however lack of funding closed the program. We have also submitted proposals to funders to acquire funds to provide counselling and groups to men who are either perpetrators or the abused. No success yet.

True Essence Counselling Inc.

Lack of funding for clients that do not have the financial resources to pay for the program.

Vancouver Native Health Society Positive Outlook Program Counselling Services

Treatment for complex trauma as well as violence/anger needs more attention and resources due to specific identified challenges including long-term commitment for therapeutic benefits.

West End Seniors' Network Society (WESN)

Thank you for including us in your survey. Like many seniors organizations, we are challenged to develop programming that is of interest to older men (women are far more likely to join). We continue to explore options.

Westcoast Family Centres Society

This program refers men and boys to other agencies that provide group, clinical counselling or parenting groups. We find that the community lacks programs for assaultive males that have not been charged and where "anger management" courses do not address their belief system that justifies the violence against their partners. It is also very difficult to find programs or supports for male victims in abusive relationships.

NORTH COAST/NECHAKO REGION

Northern Society for Domestic Peace - Houston

There is a lack of ethical counselling services for men who use violence in their relationships. Inadequate services are available for men who are involved in the justice system. We have had to fund-raise to provide services to men who volunteer. We lack appropriate cultural services for communities in the northwest, and need services for men who have experienced sexual abuse. Appears to be no funding and desire to provide such services from the province.

Northern Society for Domestic Peace - Smithers

There is a lack of ethical counselling services for men who use violence in their relationships. Inadequate services are available for men who are involved in the justice system. We have had to fund-raise to provide services to men who volunteer. We lack appropriate cultural services for communities in the northwest, and need services for men who have experienced sexual abuse. Appears to be no funding and desire to provide such services from the province.

Prince Rupert Seniors' Centre Association

No transition housing for men.

NORTHWEST REGION

North Peace Community Resources Society

We did a men's survey in 2012 and know there is a need for men's counselling services but have no resources to offer them. There seems to be a sense in our society that men can look after their own problems but that women need support. Everyone would benefit if we could also help men.

THOMPSON/OKANAGAN REGION

Access Resources

Life Horizons Counselling Program offers support counselling to adult clients with a cognitive delay and have been referred through Community Living British Columbia. CLBC offers referrals for clients that require many different forms of counseling and support.

Central Okanagan Hospice Association

One main difficulty in offering grief programs is that men often just do not come. The proportion of our services that go towards women is much greater than to men. This could be tied in to cultural expectations of men being the 'strong ones', or that many men are not interested or comfortable sharing their feelings. I hope that with improved dialogue men will feel more comfortable expressing & experiencing their grief and loss.

West Bank First Nation

Lack of funding and time

VANCOUVER ISLAND/COAST REGION

AIDS Vancouver Island

We recognize a long-standing gap in psychological, physical and emotional supports for gay, bi, trans, men who have sex with men on Vancouver Island due to homophobia, transphobia and heterosexism. It's a continuing struggle to know where to send men who are looking for these supports in our island communities.

Community Based Victim Services - Comox Valley Family Services Association

Jennifer Woods Feedback: Negative: Government did away with abusive men's programs thru John Howard Society.
Negative: No counselling for male victims of domestic violence.

Community Options Society (COS)

Historically few local options for men with issues around anger and violence -general lack of funding for the kind of service you are providing.

Comox Valley Hospice Society

It has been quite some time since we've offered a 'mens only' bereavement group for a variety of reasons including a lack of facilitators available and small numbers of men compared with women willing to attend a group. We utilize volunteers as group facilitators primarily to reduce financial burden of having staff involved in the groups.

Comox Valley Youth as Caregivers

Having all local agencies aware of all the programs available to males in the area. Some are somewhat duplicated. A few non-profit programs are not male oriented, use blame/shame, have a female oriented agenda or do not have the depth/knowledge/resources required to have a positive effect. This keeps the male client away from seeking help.

Family Place Partnership

We have had a number of men continue with sobriety for a number of years and still are in the group to support others. This group is the only one of its kind here in Port Hardy area and is in danger of being shut down. I have had 20-30 men pass through the group over the years. Many of them still keep in contact and enjoy knowing that there is something out there for them when they need it. It would be sad to see this program disappear.

Men's Trauma Centre

It continues to be difficult to access funding for counselling for men. Often if there is a wait list the client is not reachable when we do call back to offer service. This means that many men who reach out for help do not get the service they need.

North Island Survivors' Healing Society

Men's counselling for abuse-related trauma does not have core government funding. This is problematic for many reasons. As providers for Stopping The Violence counselling for women, we have benefitted greatly from stable contract funds, accountability and resources through the Ministry of Justice and a professional organization that is a liaison with government. In order to operate the comparable men's program we submit annual applications through Gaming and United Way as well as participating in a hefty amount of fund raising. We are fortunate to receive funds from both Gaming and United Way but it is significantly less stable than comparable women's programs and in many ways this lack of recognition has a negative impact on men who already feel isolated in the challenges they are facing. Lack of funds has also limited our capacity to meet the demand for this program. As the only professional counselling program available for all men who are survivors of abuse for the north island and outlying islands, for a heavily subsidized, nominal user fee, there is a tremendous amount of work to be done and we would like to have the hours to do it. The pay is low for the credentials, training and consultation required to do this important work. The local economy has been hit hard which has negatively impacted the United Way campaign and our own capacity to fundraise and Gaming has a clear mandate that prohibits them from being the core funders of any programs. We are concerned that without a more stable and higher funding structure that many of these small grass root attempts to provide these important services will erode with time.

Restorative Justice Victoria

Lack of funding.

Salt Spring Wellness Programs

Lack of funding or coordination for volunteer programs is increasingly a problem, for us and others.

The Compassionate Friends of Canada - Nanaimo Chapter

I have done a personal survey on Vancouver Island regarding Bereavement Support or After Care programs and found that resources are next to none...other than hospice. To offset costs for resource materials and operating costs then funding is crucial. To offer the communities programs that are essential to the well-being of families and save the health system hundreds of dollars in medical and pharmaceutical services then it is time that programs like, The Compassionate Friends of Canada and West Coast Men's Support Society are taken seriously. FUNDING is essential!

The Nanaimo Men's Resource Centre

We have a Community Education Program, Family Maintenance Enforcement Support Program, and a DNA Testing Program. LACK OF FUNDING is the biggest problem we have.

Tsartlip First Nations

I spoke to the Nurse Heather, who thought the Directory was a good idea. They had a men's circle every Thursday morning, but the employee who ran it is not with them anymore. They are trying to hire someone else. They also have a Youth Group.

Victoria Native Friendship Centre

As with most programs that are preventative in nature, funding remains an issue. With additional funding, the program could be expanded to include the partners and children involved.

Westcoast Community Resources Society

Our Society would be interested in expanding to offer counselling and personal support services to individual males aged 19+. It is a frustration to have clients "age out" of a program's mandate and have nowhere to direct them. There are no local stable on-going free services offered to men for counselling or self-development other than Mental Health and Addictions through Vancouver Island Health Authority. There has been a young men's group held in a local first nation community but limited to that community's membership. Currently our Community Outreach program offers practical support (taxes, government form completion, navigating systems) but cannot offer the kind of emotional support sometimes needed in stressful times for clients. We have not yet found a stable funding source and our population base is not large enough to feasibly fundraise to support a program. Finding qualified staff would be a challenge (recruitment and retention). Our board of directors supports exploring options for establishing men's services. WCRS supports Westcoast Restorative Justice which is becoming active again after a short hiatus. The new program has a coordinator and several trained forum facilitators. Their case load is beginning to increase.
